BYLAW II MEMBERSHIP

- 1. Any person who:
 - a. Has attained the age of 19 years, and
 - b. Supports the mission statement of the Camp Artaban Society, and
 - c. Either:
 - i. is an active member of an Anglican or other Christian parish, or
 - ii. is approved to become a member at a general meeting of the members, or
 - iii. has been a member within the previous three years, and
- d. Has not been expelled pursuant to these bylaws, is eligible for membership or membership renewal.

2. Memberships:

- a. May be purchased at rates recommended by the Board of Directors, and approved by the membership at the following AGM,
- b. expire on December 31 of each year;
- c. fees include all applicable taxes; and
- d. changes in fees take effect on January 1 of the following year.
- 3. The Bishop of the Diocese of New Westminster is an ex officio member of the Society and is exempt from all fees.
- 4. The Board of Directors may recommend to the membership that *Life Membership* be conferred upon any person who has made in money or services a substantial or valuable contribution to the Society. *Life Members* are exempt from all fees.
- 5. All Members shall uphold the Constitution and comply with these Bylaws.
- 6. A member may be expelled from the Society if the Board of Directors considers that their conduct is prejudicial to the interest of the Society.
- 7. A member so expelled may apply for readmission to the Society one time only. If three-quarters of the members in attendance at a duly constituted General Meeting are in favour of their readmission, they shall be readmitted upon compliance with such other provisions of this Bylaw as may be applicable.
