

WHAT TO PACK

FOR CAMP

- Personal clothing and footwear
 - Suitable for the outdoors, sunshine and rain
 - Warm layer for evenings, shoes for rocky beaches, etc.
- Toiletries
- Towel and Wash Cloth
- Bedding
 - Sleeping Bag, Pillows, Etc.
- Flashlight
 - Extra batteries
- Water Bottle
- Cocoa Mug
- Personal Charger for Devices
- Sunscreen and Bug Spray
- Masks

Optional Items:

- Camera
- Musical Instrument
- Books
- Sunglasses
- Extra Blankets
- Snacks
- Camping chairs
- Hiking boots, backpacks, etc.
- Beach toys

Tenting Specifics:

- Tent
- Sleeping mat
 In addition to other bedding
- Lantern
- Sealable food-storage containers

DO NOT BRING...

- Any nut or "may contain" food product
- Valuables
- Weapons or Drugs
- Pets or Animals



LUGGAGE ALLOWANCE

PROCEDURE

Luggage is limited for the safety of our staff and space on the boats.

- Campers are allowed **ONE** piece of luggage of under **20kg** (44lbs) per piece, sleeping bag & pillow and **ONE** small day pack. <u>DO NOT PACK IN GARBAGE BAGS!*</u>
- Use ONLY duffel bags, packs or strong suitcases that close securely. Do not attach any items to the outside of luggage. (Please use waterproof luggage/bags whenever possible.)
- 3. Write camper's name on all luggage in large, clear letters.

*NOTE: Please DO NOT pack items in garbage bags, as the gear goes through significant handling to and from camp. Garbage bags rip, leaving contents spilled, lost, dropped, etc.
